ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.08 WEEDS AND RUBBISH

WHEREAS, it is necessary to simplify and update various ordinances in the Town from time to time, and

WHEREAS, in order to simplify enforcement of weeds and rubbish ordinances, this Chapter and Section should be amended,

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Dolores, Colorado Section 8.08.010 Abatement - Generally shall be amended by adding a paragraph C which shall read as follows:

C. A violation of this section shall be punished as set forth in Section 1.12.010 General Penalty.

Repealer. All orders, bylaws, ordinances, and resolutions of the Town, or parts thereof, inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.

Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, the intent being that the same are severable.

Recording and Authentication. Upon adoption hereof, this Ordinance shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose and shall be authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the Town Clerk.

PUBLIC HEARING. This ordinance shall be considered for second or final reading on the 14th day of September, 2015, at the hour of 6:30 p.m. in the Town Board Chambers in Town Hall, Dolores Colorado, at which time and place all persons may appear and be heard concerning the same.



**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF VEHICLES IN TRAFFIC THE TOWN OF
DOLORES AMENDING TITLE 10, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC REPEALING ALL
ORDINANCES AND CONFLICT THEREWITH AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION THEREOF**

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the orderly enforcement of traffic laws within the Town of Dolores to amend and update the existing Title 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC Dolores Municipal Code, and

WHEREAS, the Town needs to amend other existing ordinances to comply with the 2010 addition Model Traffic Code and remove conflicts between the 2010 Model Traffic Code and the Dolores Municipal Code.

WHEREAS, the Town of Dolores finds it necessary to limit parking to parallel only during the winter months for snow removal on certain Town streets.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordained by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Dolores, Colorado that:

Currently Part 17 Penalties and Procedures Model Traffic Code 2010 edition adopts a classification of traffic violations and imposes a schedule of penalties, fines, imprisonment or both in conflict with the Dolores Municipal Code Chapter 1.12 General Penalty.

NOW THEREFORE the Model Traffic Code 2010 edition Part 17 Penalties and Procedure is repealed, and

Section 10.04.040 Penalties Title 10 Vehicles and Traffic Chapter 10.04 Model Traffic Code of the Dolores Municipal Code is repealed and replaced with:

Section 10.04.040 Penalties.

A person who is convicted of a violation of this Title and/or of the provisions of the Colorado Model Traffic Code as adopted by the Town of Dolores shall be punished as set forth in Dolores Municipal Code Section 1.12.010 Penalties now in effect or as may be amended from time to time.

NOW THEREFORE be it further ordained that,

Section 1.12.010 Penalties A, Dolores Municipal Code reads as follows:

A. Any person who violates any of the provisions of an ordinance of the Town shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 180 days or both a fine and imprisonment.

Section 1.12.010 Penalties shall be amended to read as follows:

A. Any person who violates any of the provisions of an ordinance of the Town shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$499.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 180 days or both a fine and imprisonment.

And shall be amended to add the following:

C. Violations of Title 10 Dolores Municipal Code and the Model Traffic Code adopted by the Town of Dolores, now in effect or as may be amended from time to time shall be punished by a fine of up to \$499 only.

NOW THEREFORE be it further ordained:

Chapter 10-08 Speed Limits is repealed in its entirety

Chapter 10.12 Parking, Section 10.12.010 Parallel Parking is repealed in its entirety.

Chapter 10.12 Section 10.12.010 Parallel Parking is hereby replaced with Section 10.12.010 Angled Parking:

Pursuant to Section 12.05(3) Colorado Model Traffic Code 2010 edition as adopted by The Town of Dolores angled/diagonal parking is authorized year round only on the following streets:

- 4th Street, both sides, between Central Avenue and Railroad Avenue (Highway 145)
- Central Avenue between 4th and 5th Street, south side only.
- 5th Street between Central Avenue and Railroad Avenue (Highway 145) both sides.
- 6th between Central Avenue and Railroad Avenue (Highway 145) both sides.

Angled/Diagonal Parking is not authorized on any street except those listed above in the Town of Dolores from 1 November through 30 April yearly.

Repealer. All orders, bylaws, ordinances, and resolutions of the Town, or parts thereof, inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.

Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, the intent being that the same are severable.

Recording and Authentication. Upon adoption hereof, this Ordinance shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose and shall be authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and the Town Clerk.


