10.1 Sheriff's Report: Sheriff Steve Nowlin reported the calls for service and expenditure report. The Sheriff answered questions concerning traffic and construction on Railroad Avenue.

10.2 Managers Report: Manager Ken Charles updated the Board on the Stage one Fire Restriction placed by the Fire Protection District of Montezuma County. The Restrictions Prohibits personal use of fireworks, campfires outside of designated fire pits or fire rings, agricultural open burning without a permit issued by the Sheriff, use of explosive targets, and smoking outside or near combustible material. Updates also given on the inspection on the Wastewater Treatment Plant solar system. Charter Communications is completing the installation of cable along Merritt Was. Other items were:

- Water: The Town has adopted a more restrictive outside watering plan. Joe Rowell Park's watering plan has been reduced to every other night, for 30 minutes. This schedule will be used for Flanders Park and Riverside Park as well. Manager Charles mentioned that Citizens of the Town are doing a good job of restrictive watering also.
- Salter Y EA: The Forest Service has released the Final Environmental Assessment, in which there was no significant impact.
- Review of the sales tax report.
- Manager Charles also updated the Board on the upcoming Agenda for July 26th, 2021.

10.3 Town Attorney: Jon Kelly talked about the amendments to the land use code. He brought up the nuisance ordinance and the need for revising.

11. BOARDS/COMMISSIONS:

11.1 Parks/Playground Advisory Committee: Manager Charles updated the Board on the Parks Committees actions. Kalin Grigg and Cliff Stephens are working on the pickets and are nearing completion. Tree plaques will require being imbedded in concrete. Benches will be installed time permitting. The Public Works Crew completed installing the soccer goals. River Trail steps are installed. Nikki is working with Public Works on the pump track maintenance. Manager Charles remarked that the no parking signs at Big Rock are being removed by citizens and the area is littered. The owner of the property is working with the Sheriff and Public Works on installation of signs.

11.2 Planning & Zoning: Linda Robinson updated the Board on the Land Use Code progress. The Committee reviewed Article 11 which is hazards and environmentally sensitive areas and Article 17 Specific Development Review Procedures. She mentioned the public hearing for a marijuana Conditional Use Permit and expressed her appreciation to the Manager for reviewing it with the Board.

12. OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS:

12.1 Chamber of Commerce: Director Susan Lisak reported that Summerfest will be going on for the weekend of the July 7th, 2021. Events will include a doggy carnival, pet adoption, kid sprinkler and foam from the Fire department. Vendors, Bands, and a Car Show. She also stated that there will be an Arts & Crafts show at the Dolores Community Center.

15. ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD BUSINESS:

15.1 Action/Discussion: A proposal from the Galloping Goose Historical Society for a Railroad Car display in Flanders Park. Manager Charles presented a diagram showing the proposed placement of the cars in the park. Also were plans of operation. Manager Charles explained the placement of proposed display tracks and presented measurements to where the cars will be placed.

15.2 Discussion/Direction; for a Community Intervention Program. Axis Health System has been working with Montezuma County, City of Cortez, and Town of Mancos to develop a system to respond to nonviolent crisis for citizens of the area. The Community Intervention Program (CIP) staff would respond to non-emergency situations for mental illness, homelessness, addictions, and welfare checks. This will also aide Law Officers to move on to more important emergencies. Haley Leonard Saunders of Axis explained to the Board the number of calls received for help in Montezuma County. This will make sure individuals who cannot care for themselves would be assisted. She explained there are calls for domestic violence, suicide threats, substance abuse just to name a few. She added that crimes against children are increasing. The hope is to begin planning January 1, 2022. The Board was asked for their support. It was the consensus that further discussion would be needed.

15.3 Action/Discussion: Developing a plan to add bathrooms to Flanders Park and apply grant funding from the CDOT-Revitalizing Main Streets Program. Manager Charles introduced the proposal to the Board. The architectural costs would be the responsibility of the Town in the amount of \$10,000.00. Manager Charles emailed CDOT and received a response that was encouraging. Upon Board members agreeing with the proposal, Manager Charles will move forward with developing a plan to add restrooms to Flanders Park.

Trustee Stark brought some opinions from the public concerning booths at the Summerfest event. The comments made were concerning a political and religious booth. Some of the opinions were in opposition of these events. Attorney Kelly explained the legality of freedom of speech and the Towns involvement concerning these opinions. He further explained that the event was held by the Dolores Chamber of Commerce. Chamber of Commerce Director Susan Lisak stated that the vendors were peaceful and had no issues during the event.

Trustee Murphy move to approve the Special Event Liquor License for Escalante Days by the Dolores Chamber of Commerce for August 14th, 2021, from the hours of 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., seconded by Trustee Wheeler. Motion carried by five yes and one no vote.

10. STAFF REPORTS/PRESENTATIONS:

10.1 Managers Report from Manager Ken Charles. Manager Charles informed the Board the San Juan Forest lifted the Stage 1 Fire restriction on July 22nd, 2021. The BLM and Montezuma County have not lifted the restrictions.

- General updates were on CDOT 145 paving project. It is scheduled for completion by July 23, 2021. The Sheriff and Public Works have placed two no trespassing signs along Riverside Avenue, 6th street, and 9th street.
- The Town hired a new temporary seasonal public works employee until October.
- Two Community Intervention Program meetings have been held.
- New stop signs were installed on Hillside Avenue, 8th, and 9th streets. A no outlet sign has been ordered for 2nd street. The Water Treatment Plant has been repaired and is producing 90,000 gallons daily. Water demand is down due to the recent rains.
- Salter Y EA: The Town is reviewing the EA and will make replies/objections before the due date. The Town Model Traffic Code requires trucks over a certain size must have mufflers. For the record a copy of a letter drafted by the Town Board concerning objections to the San Juan Forest Service EA was submitted in the packet for review.

10.2 Attorney's Report: Attorney Jon Kelly discussed issues on item 9.1 previously in the meeting making a presentation that:

- The Town is not promoting or endorsing the ideas or speech made by vendors permitted booth space by organization that is granted a permit to hold an event on Town property—the Town does not violate the Establishment Clause of the constitution when such vendors express religious or political views;
- A park is a “traditional public forum” which is governed by Unites States Supreme Court holdings on the First Amendment right to free speech;
- When the Town issues a permit for an event in a park it is not permitted to implement policies or conditions that prohibit or regulate the content of political or religious speech;

- The Town is permitted to impose reasonable conditions on the time, place and manner of the use of public parks so long as such conditions do not hinder discriminate against specific types of speech.

13.1 Liquor License: For a Beer & Wine License located at the Whistlers Walk on 101 S. 11th Street, Dolores Colorado. Mayor Pro Tem Truelsen opened the public hearing for comment. Jason Parker owner of the Whistler's Walk introduced himself. No public comment was made. Mayor Pro Tem Truelsen closed the hearing and asked for a motion.

Trustee Wheeler moved to approve the Beer and Wine Liquor License for Whistlers Walk, seconded by Trustee Stark. Motion passed unanimously.

13.2 Conditional Use Permit: For property owned by Dan Heeney and business owner Patrick Labruzzo owner of High-Country Releaf. At this time Trustee Stark stepped down and recused herself from the hearing per conflict-of-interest stated earlier. Mayor Pro Tem Truelsen opened the public hearing for comment. Property Owner Mike Tobin who is located next door commented that he and Mr. Heeney have a Gentleman's Agreement concerning the lot line on the property. Property owner Dan Heeney also commented on the lot line as well. Business owner Patrick Labruzzo was present virtually to answer questions. Hearing no other comments, Trustee Truelsen closed the hearing for Board discussion. The Board discussed parking issues, the lot line, signage, and employee parking. 6 conditions were listed, and 3 more were added at the end of the discussion.

Trustee Murphy moved to approve the conditional use permit for High-Country Releaf providing the following conditions are completed:

1. *Signs must meet code and face HWY 145 (Railroad Avenue)*
2. *Signage lights only illuminate during operational hours.*
3. *Additional Parking Sign the directs marijuana customers to the west side of the building.*
4. *A sign that directs Rustic Style Furniture Customers to the west side of the building.*
5. *Build a privacy fence on the agreed upon boundary between 102 Railroad Avenue and 200 S. 2nd street.*
6. *Dark Sky compliant lighting will be met per application.*
7. *Employee parking will be off sight and not South of Railroad on 2nd Street.*
8. *Lot line adjustment between 102 Railroad and 200 2nd street, occurring within 6 months of the Conditional Use Permit.*
9. *Hour of operation will be 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.*

Trustee Lewis seconded. Motion was carried unanimously.

Monday/s Town Board Meeting

On the agenda for our regular meeting Monday night, the Trustees begin with considering several items on the consent agenda followed by Department, Planning Commission, Parks and Recreation Committee and Chamber reports. There is a Resolution to rescind the fire ban and a resolution codifying the Conditional Use permit for the retail marijuana store located at 102 Railroad.

Stage 1 Fire Restrictions in Place Montezuma County (Continued)

The Montezuma County Sheriff, and Fire Chiefs representing fire protection districts of Montezuma County have rescinded their respective fire bans and the sheriff has recommended the Town of Dolores follow those leads. Included in the packet is the resolution lifting the Town's fire ban.

Land Use Code Update

The Town's Land Use Code consultant, Elizabeth Garvin, is planning to facilitate a day long workshop on Saturday August 21 from 9-3 at town hall. Elizabeth will be presenting the draft of the full LUC update to the P&Z. All town board members and members of the public are invited. The meeting will be noticed as a special meeting of the town board in anticipation of more than 2 members attending.

General Updates

- The Town mailed the STR License applications to those 15 property owners who are either already operating a STR and to those who have contacted the town with plans to open an STR.
- All three solar systems are complete and generating electricity. The Town treasurer will be monitoring the results as it pertains to the billing for the three meters at the WWTP, Town Hall and Town Shop. Shaw Solar said that the system at the WWTP is the second largest system they have installed to date.
- The Town Manager, Linda Robinson and Marianne Mate met with AquaHab to develop a proposal to improve the public fishing access points. Members of the Parks and Recreation committee thought after 20 years it was time to review and improve our access to the river and eventually apply for a State Fishing is Fun grant. AquaHab originally designed and constructed the Dolores River fishing improvements 20 years ago.
- I have been contacting architects to work on the Flanders Park restroom design. The town's building official concluded that both the Museum restrooms and the two former restrooms on the north side of town hall are not of adequate size to meet ADA requirements. I will be asking the Parks and Recreation Committee for their guidance regarding developing a master plan for Flanders



Park. It appears to be a prudent action given all the activity either already moving forward or being proposed. This includes the Museum tracks/boxcars north of the museum, a restroom and the winter storage structure near the water tank for the Galloping Goose.

- Region 9 approved the request by the Bridge Shelter in Cortez as an Enterprise Zone Contribution Project. The Bridge provides shelter to the homeless. The Bridge is seeking contributions for operations. When a project is included as an Enterprise Zone project contributions are tax deductible.
- The four local governments, law enforcement and Axis Health in Montezuma County continue to meet with regards to the Community Intervention Project (CIP). We are moving to a population-based approach to develop the contributions from each government. That would put the town's contribution closer to \$25,000 down from the initial ask of \$125,000. There are several challenges yet to work. The Montezuma BOCC meet August 13 to listen to the proposal and their participation is critical to the program.
- Region 9 has published their draft Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy. **RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE GRANT FOR
PROPERTY LOCATED AT Railroad Avenue PURSUANT
TO ARTICLE VI(K) OF THE DOLORES LAND USE CODE AND THE
DOLORES MARIJUANA CODE ORDINANCE NUMBER 556 Series 2021**

WHEREAS, the Town of Dolores, Colorado (“Town”) is a Colorado Statutory Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Trustees are vested with the statutory authority to administer the affairs of the Town; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2021, the Town Trustees approved the application of Patrick Labruzzo doing business through High Country Releaf, LLC for a license to operate a retail marijuana store at 102 Railroad Avenue subject to conditions among which was to obtain a conditional use permit to operate at that location;

WHEREAS, Dan Heeney, the property owner, and Patrick Labruzzo, the manager of High Country Releaf, LLC, filed an application for a conditional use grant to allow the operation of a retail marijuana dispensary on a portion of the premises located at 102 Railroad Avenue with the remainder of the premises continuing its existing use of a log furniture manufacturing business (“Property”); and

WHEREAS, the Property is located in the Commercial Highway District and is adjacent to an existing residential use; and

WHEREAS, The Dolores Marijuana Code, Appendix A, provides that marijuana business may be permitted adjacent to an existing residential zone or use upon approval of a conditional use permit as provided by the Dolores Marijuana Code and Article VI(K) of the Dolores Land Use Code (hereinafter the “Codes”); and

WHEREAS, Article VI(K) of the Dolores Land Use Code and Appendix A of the Dolores Marijuana Code regulate conditional use grants, setting forth, among other matters, the petition process and the criteria for consideration of a conditional use permit; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2021, pursuant to said Codes, and after proper notice, the Planning and Zoning Commission conducted a public hearing and recommended approval of the conditional use permit to operate a retail marijuana store at the Property subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2021, pursuant to said Codes and after proper notice, the Town Trustees, held a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, after considering the Planning and Zoning Commission’s recommendations and the factors contained in said Codes, reviewing the file, and conducting such public hearing, the Town Trustees on July 26, 2021 voted to approve the conditional use permit subject to conditions.

WHEREAS the purpose of this resolution is to memorialize the findings and conditions approved by the Trustees on July 26, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF DOLORES, COLORADO, THAT:

1. Approval of Conditional Use Grant. The application of Dan Heeney, the property owner, and Patrick Labruzzo, the manager of High Country Releaf, LLC, for a conditional use grant to allow the operation of a retail marijuana dispensary on a portion of the premises located at 102 Railroad Avenue was approved by the Trustees by voice vote subject to the conditions set forth below.

2. Conditions of Approval. The conditional use permit was approved subject to the following conditions:

- a. Signs must meet code and face HWY 145 (Railroad Avenue)
- b. Signage lights only illuminate during operational hours.
- c. Additional Parking Sign the directs marijuana customers to the west side of the building.
- d. A sign that directs Rustic Style Furniture Customers to the west side of the building.
- e. Build a privacy fence on the agreed upon boundary between 102 Railroad Avenue and 200 S. 2nd street.
- f. Dark Sky compliant lighting will be met per application.
- g. Employee parking will be off sight and not South of Railroad on 2nd Street.
- h. Lot line adjustment between 102 Railroad and 200 2nd street, occurring within 6 months of the Conditional Use Permit.
- i. Hours of operation will be 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective on the date set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF DOLORES as follows:

1. The Board of Trustees, pursuant to Ordinance No. 536 Series 2018 and as authorized by Colorado law, hereby rescinds the June 14, 2021 Open Flame Fire Ban as defined in said Ordinance within all incorporated areas of the Town of Dolores.
2. This resolution shall continue in full force and effect until modified by the Board of Trustees.
3. The staff of the Town of Dolores shall inform the public of the rescission of the Open Flame Fire Ban.
4. If any section, clause, phrase, word other provisions of this resolution shall for any reason be held invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, phrases words or other provisions and the validity of this resolution shall stand notwithstanding.
5. Introduced, read and passed as a resolution at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Dolores held on July 9, 2021, at which a quorum was present.


RE: Removal of Fire Ban within Dolores Town Limits
