Overview

- Conceptual design performed in 2022
- Town awarded Fishing is Fun grant from CPW
- Initiated final design in late 2024
- 30% design in February 2025
- Federal permitting (Corps of Engineers) initiated in May 2025
- Coordinating with US Forest Service on access and federal permitting
- 14 proposed improvements over 2 separate reaches








Proposed Improvements

- Improved fishing access from bank
- In-stream boulder clusters for fish habitat
- J-hook boulder vanes
- Cross-vane repair
- Pool excavation
- ~\$140,000 construction budget (CPW and Town funds)




Cross-vane repair



Permitting

- Performed wetland evaluation/OHWM and developed aquatic resources report in Spring 2025
- Evaluated threatened and endangered species
- Submitted for Corps of Engineers 404 permit May 2025
- Coordinating access to Reach 1 through US Forest Service
- USFS will assist with environmental review process
- Developing floodplain no-rise for County and Town permitting



Timeline

- June/July 2025: Complete Corps of Engineers/ No-Rise permitting
- Summer 2025: Execute grant and purchase rocks from quarry in Cortez
- Summer 2025: Develop bidding documents
- Fall 2025: Select contractor
- December 2025/January 2026: Construction
