



THE FAIR CAMPAIGN PRACTICES ACT (FCPA) requires all documents must be filed in duplicate and sent to:

The Candidate Affidavit (first form attached) is required to be completed by all candidates and is to be filed with the Town Clerk/Treasurer within ten (10) days of a person filing to become a candidate.

The other FCPA forms, as they may apply, are required to be filed on the following days (C.R.S. 1-45-108(2)(a)(II)):

1. Friday, February 6, 2026: Candidate Affidavit, donations and expenditure forms, or non-receipt of donation form, Agreement to spending limits, as applicable
2. Tuesday, March 17, 2026: Disclosure forms, non-receipt of donation form.
3. Friday, April 3, 2026: Disclosure forms, non-receipt of donation form
4. Thursday, May 12, 2026: Disclosure of revenues & expenditures
5. January 15, 2027: For committees that don't terminate by year-end- C.R.S. 1-45-108
6. Termination Report: Upon final activity and zero balance. File after winding down all activity- C.R.S. 1-45-107.5

Donations of \$20.00 or more must be itemized. For a donation of \$100 or more, you will need the donator's name, address, occupation and employer. Contributors may make contributions using cash, crypto currencies, check, money order, credit card, EFT, etc., but cash, coin or crypto currency contributions cannot exceed \$100.00. **Volunteer services by an individual are not considered contributions.**

The FCPA forms are attached. Extra forms are available at the Town Clerk's office.

The information above is considered a summary and does not include all regulations of the Fair Campaign Practices Act. Candidates are required to read the Campaign & Political Finance Manual version 12/2024 in its entirety. That manual may be found here:
